ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- Each applicant must be a member in good standing of the Providence for at least five (5) years with a current insurance or annuity certificate that has a minimum face value or balance of \$5,000.
 - Applicant must be a full time college student who completed one (1) semester of college work, or graduated High School and has been accepted to college.
 - cumulative grade of 3.3 (or equivalent).
 - seeking a Bachelor degree.

- Original transcript of the applicant's college records indicating a cumulative grade of 3.3 (or equivalent) at the conclusion of the Fall Semester. High School transcript indicating a cumulative grade of 3.3 (or equivalent) after graduation, and a letter of acceptance to a college.
 - A letter of recommendation from the Pastor of the applicant's church.
 - An essay of not less than five (500) hundred words. Theme: "What can I contribute to our Ukrainian Catholic Church and Community after completing my education?"
 - Recent wallet (2x3) head shot photograph and brief biography for publication purposes.
- **Deadline for Academic Scholarship: August 15**
 - Previous awardees may re-apply up to four (4) times.
